Those children who have <u>not</u> attended our Pre-school will attend two transition days on <u>Thursday 2nd September and Friday 3rd September from 8.45am - 3.15pm.</u> This will allow this smaller group of children two days to get to know their new school and the staff in Early Years before the whole class joins on <u>Monday 6th September</u>.
